Main Objective

On February 9, 2016, the agreement between Georgia and the European Investment Bank, which was aimed at improving the municipal infrastructure, entered into force. However, On December 21, 2020, the contract was reprogrammed and due to the challenges caused by the COVID-19 pandemic, a new agreement was signed. The main priority of which was to strengthen the Georgian healthcare system. The program is divided into two parts: COVID-19 specific schemes and public health schemes.

COVID19 Specific Schemes

- Equipment and consumables (protective materials and equipment, hygiene and disinfection measures) purchased to tame the pandemic of COVID-19 in line with the relevant national pandemic or civil protection/disaster plans.
- Vaccines and vaccination campaigns against COVID-19.

Public Health Care Schemes

- Public Health Care Schemes are aimed at improving the provision of public health care services refurbishment, construction and equipping of public healthcare infrastructure throughout Georgia;
